Terms and Conditions for Mick Young Scholarship Applicants

The TAFE Directors Australia National Scholarships Foundation (the Foundation) provides annual scholarships for financially disadvantaged, motivated students studying at public Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) – TAFEs and dual-sector public universities in Australia.

These are known as Mick Young Scholarships and are equity scholarships available to students experiencing financial hardship and who are motivated to complete their course of study. The scholarships are open to existing and potential students.

1. The scholarship structure:

- The scholarship will assist with study costs for one year at <<insert your Institute name>>
- Scholarships are awarded to worthy applicants who, at the absolute discretion of the Foundation, have fulfilled the selection criteria
- Each scholarship is for the academic year in which it is awarded
- The amount of payment will be \$500 - \$1,000.

2. Eligibility criteria: Applicants -

- Must be financially disadvantaged and be committed to doing well in their studies
- Can be studying full or part time
- Be studying, or intending to study, an Approved Australian Course listed on www.training.gov.au
- Must demonstrate initiative and motivation to succeed in their chosen course of study
- Must be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident

3. Administration of scholarships:

- Shortlisting of eligible scholarship recipients will be conducted by a selection panel comprising at least three representatives from <<insert your Institute name>>, and possibly a representative from the Foundation donor, or sponsor if applicable.
- The panel will interview shortlisted applicants and then forward its recommendations to the Foundation, who will choose the successful applicants to receive scholarships. These decisions are final, and are based on how critical additional financial support is to applicants' ability to commence/continue and succeed in their studies and on their motivation to do so.
- Applicants or <<insert your Institute name>> may be contacted by the Foundation for further information.
- <<insert your Institute name>> will notify all applicants, in writing (email), of the outcome of their application.
- All information supplied to panel members, student services and administration officers and the Foundation is treated as confidential.

4. Conditions of award:

- Scholarships are paid in full as a single grant. The mode of payment is at the discretion of the Foundation in consultation with <<insert your Institute name>>.
- Scholarships are valid for a one-year period of study, however recipients and previous applicants of the scholarship can re-apply each year.
- Scholarships may be transferred to another Institute if a student is no longer able to continue their course at <<insert your Institute name>>.

- Scholarships are to be spent on course-related costs, such as fees, text books, living expenses and travel costs.
- Each recipient is to use his/her best endeavour to successfully complete the program of study.
- Each recipient must give at least one month's notice in writing to the <<insert relevant position>> in the event of any of the following:
 - Transfer to another course within <<insert your Institute name>>
 - Transfer to another Institute
- Should a recipient be no longer meet the eligibility criteria, the scholarship may need to be paid back in part or in full.

5. Termination of scholarship:

The Foundation has discretion to terminate a scholarship and to recover payment in the event of any of the following:

- The behaviour of the recipient on or off campus is considered to bring disgrace upon the Scholarship, <<insert your Institute name>> or the Foundation.
- The program of study is being undertaken with insufficient diligence or not in accordance with the terms of the Scholarship.
- Cancellation of enrolment.
- Deferral of study in the year of the award without sufficient rationale.
